People are frequently illegally trafficked through India for the purposes of commercial exploitation and forced/bonded labour. Men, women and children are trafficked in India for diverse reasons. Women and girls are trafficked within the country for the purposes of commercial sexual exploitation and forced marriage. Involuntary Domestic Servitude children are very vulnerable when it comes to Domestic servitude. Often children are told that they will be offered excellent wages to work as a maid in middle-class homes, but they usually end up being severely underpaid, abused, and sometimes assaulted, these forced labours lose all freedom, being thrown into the workforce, essentially becoming slaves, and losing their childhood.
